## FOREWORD

This booklet contains the schedule of courses (not including M4 electives) offered to medical students at Howard University College of Medicine. It provides a calendar of events, examination dates, and schedule of clerkships. Where applicable, non-medical graduate students enrolled in medical school courses will comply with the class and examination schedules set forth in this booklet. The respective departments will schedule other courses, seminars, and examinations for graduate and other students. **The schedules do not show dates and times for quizzes and other evaluations. This schedule can change, if so, all will be notified.**

## CURRICULUM – M.D. PROGRAM

The College of Medicine’s program of instruction provides the forum for students to acquire the essential knowledge, skills, behaviors and attitudes necessary for the practice of medicine as set forth in the Educational Objectives for Howard University College of Medicine. The details of these objectives are shown in the College of Medicine Policies and Procedures Manual, also called the “Policies Manual”. In addition, time is provided during the M4 year schedule for elective courses (Senior Electives Courses), so that students can explore areas of special interests.

### **First Year (M1)**

The first-year integrated curriculum has **seven** instructional units. They include two units of instruction in Molecules and Cells, three units of instruction in Structure and Function and two units of instruction in Population Health+. Instruction in clinical skills and communication skills are included in the Population Health+ units.

The first semester instructional units in Molecules and Cells include macromolecules and metabolism, molecular and cell biology, tissue histology, nutrition, basic microbiology, genetics and immunology. The Population Health+ units includes instruction in population health, social determinates of health, health systems science and clinical/communication skills development. The Structure and Function units begin in the first semester with instruction in bones, muscles and skin.

During the second semester, the Structure and Function units include head and neck; nervous system; thorax; abdomen and pelvis. The Population Health+ unit includes nutrition, global and environmental health.

### **Second Year (M2)**

The second-year integrated curriculum has **nine** units. The curriculum includes six units of instruction covering the Organ Systems, two units in Introduction to Clinical Medicine (including physical diagnostic skills and behaviors), and one unit of Population Health+. Instructions in clinical skills and communication skills are included in the units taught throughout this year.

During the first semester, instructional units in the Organ Systems include general principles; hematopoietic, lymphoreticular, musculoskeletal and skin systems; cardiovascular and respiratory systems; and the renal, endocrine and genitourinary systems. There is a semester-long unit in Introduction to Clinical Medicine.

During the second semester, the Organ Systems include instructional units covering the gastrointestinal and reproductive systems; the central nervous system and specific topics. Introduction to Patient Care and Population Health+ are two other units in the second semester. The Population Health+ unit includes complementary/alternative medicine, behavioral health, biostatistics/epidemiology and a life-long learning group project.

### **Third and Fourth Years (M3 and M4)**

The third- and fourth-year curricula consist of instruction in a continuum of clerkships (internal medicine {inpatient and outpatient}/neurology/**physical medicine & rehabilitation**, family medicine/community health, surgery, obstetrics & gynecology, pediatrics, psychiatry, and emergency medicine) and examinations in the various clinical subjects. All M3 students are required to take a course in Interdisciplinary Health Care Ethics and Jurisprudence either during the first or the second semester. During the fourth year, there are three required rotations – internal medicine AI, surgery AI and the intern readiness course. During the

internal medicine and surgery rotations, students function as acting interns (AI). All fourth-year students are required to take the *Intern Readiness Course* (IRC). The IRC is a transition to residency course that focuses on clinical and procedural skills that first year residents are expected to perform. In addition to the required senior year rotations, each student has the opportunity to select four or five electives in clinical specialties and research. All rotations during the fourth year are four (4) weeks in duration. All clinical rotations (required or electives) must be approved by the Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs.

## ELECTIVES

Time is available for elective courses presented in the form of lectures, research, seminars or clinical experiences. These electives are designed to broaden the basic knowledge acquired in the core curriculum and to meet the needs of individual students that arise from differences in background, interests, and choice of careers in medicine or medically-related professions. The Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs must approve all electives. *(Please refer to the Senior Elective Courses Booklet for details)*

**Elective Requirements:** Elective time is not available during the M3 academic year. However, in the fourth year, a maximum of twenty (20) weeks or a minimum of sixteen (16) weeks must be spent in elective courses or research activity. No more than eight (8) weeks (if 16 weeks of electives are chosen) can be spent in the same specialty, or subspecialty and no more than eight (8) weeks in research.

During senior electives, students may simultaneously serve as externs or receive compensation as a US Public Health Service appointee in connection with an approved elective. The elective, however, must be a training experience and temporary employment cannot be substituted for electives.

**Intramural electives:** Students have the option of taking electives at Howard University Hospital (HUH).

**Extramural Electives:** In choosing electives, senior students may enroll in courses offered at Howard University (described in the booklet, "Senior Elective Courses") or, upon approval, electives may be taken at another institution in the United States. Application for most extramural electives is facilitated by the Visiting Student Learning Opportunity (VSLO). The process is detailed in the electives booklet that is published annually. The Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs makes final approval of electives prior to transmitting the application to the extramural host institution where the elective is to be taken.

**Visiting Students:** Students from LCME-accredited medical schools and students from accredited schools of osteopathic medicine may be accepted for electives in the fourth year at Howard University, provided space is available. **Each visiting student must provide the following:**

- Name of elective
- Institution where the student will rotate for the elective
- Dates for the electives
- Supervisor or contact person for each elective
- Other requested (by the Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs) information

**Service Learning:** A list of opportunities for students in the College of Medicine to participate in service-learning activities is maintained in the Office of the Associate Dean for Student Affairs and Admissions. The College of Medicine encourages and will support students to participate in these activities to the extent

possible. Also, the Office of Students Affairs and Admissions oversees student's organizations and their service-learning activities.

**Scholarly Activities/Research Opportunities:** The College of Medicine encourages students to participate in research. In addition to taking electives in research in the senior year, opportunities also exist during all 4 years in the curriculum for students to participate in scholarly activities. There are extramural and intramural opportunities for research. Students should contact the Associate Dean for Research for more information.

## **OTHER PROGRAMS**

### **Combined B.S./M.D. Program**

This is a cooperative program at Howard University jointly sponsored by the College of Medicine and the College of Arts and Sciences. This program allows a student to complete the requirements for both the B.S. and the M.D. degrees in six (or seven) years instead of the customary eight years. A limited number of students are admitted to the medical program (if requirements are met) from the College of Arts and Sciences as part of the entering class of traditionally selected students.

### **Combined M.D./Ph.D. Program**

The College of Medicine and the Graduate School co-sponsor this interdisciplinary program, which prepares students for leadership roles as clinicians/scientists/scholars. The requirements for both the M.D. degree and the Ph.D. degree in the biomedical program in the college of medicine can be completed in approximately seven or eight years without any diminution in either the M.D. or Ph.D. curriculum. The student will be able to select a discipline of interest from the following departments: Anatomy, Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Genetics and Genomics, Microbiology, Pharmacology, and Physiology and Biophysics. In addition, an opportunity for an interdepartmental neurosciences discipline is available.

### **Dual M.D./M.B.A. Degrees Program**

A limited number of medical students in the College of Medicine may enroll in the MBA program, so that at the end of five years these students will receive the M.D. and the M.B.A. degrees. Students must meet the criteria for admission to the MBA program and must also successfully complete the first two or three years of the medical school curriculum. Students will be required to sit for and pass the USMLE Step 1 examination before starting the MBA program. The students will then be granted a one-year leave of absence from the College of Medicine to enroll in the Business School. After successful completion of the MBA curriculum, the students then returns to the College of Medicine to complete the requirements for the M.D. degree. Medical students who wish to enroll in this program may obtain more information from the Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs in the College of Medicine and the Howard University School of Business and must write a letter to the said Associate Dean requesting permission prior to applying for the MBA program.

## ACADEMIC SUPPORT PROGRAMS

### **Student Academic Support Program (SASP)**

The Office of Medical Education (OME) presents problem solving, critical thinking and assessment of learning styles strategies to medical students during M1 Orientation week and during the early part of the first semester. Individual sessions are also offered throughout the school year. Academic support is offered to all students. Students who are identified as requiring academic reinforcement are referred to the OME for academic counseling and/or group tutorial support.

### **MedSTAR (Medical Student Taught Academic Review)**

The MedSTAR program include medical students who serve as tutors and who are selected based on their academic performance, scholastic standing and personality traits to aid students who request support in handling course content.

Academic Support also includes intensive review sessions that are presented during the summer in the **Summer Directed Study Program (SDSP)** for students who have incurred transcript unsatisfactory grade(s) during the regular school year. The Committee on Promotions and Graduation prescribes enrollment in the Summer Directed Study Program for those students considered eligible in accordance with the Policy on Student Promotions of the College of Medicine. Other programs to increase retention and graduation of students include **re-examinations, repeat clerkship, repeat an academic year, and in some cases, financial support** for review courses in preparation for the USMLE. Please see the Policies Manual for further information about these opportunities.

## GRADES, PROMOTION AND GRADUATION

A statement of the policy governing student promotions is provided to each student at the beginning of each academic year. The Committee on Student Promotions and Graduation of the College of Medicine will review student performances and make decisions concerning promotions throughout the year. A report of grades is provided to each student following each course/clerkship/elective. The Office of Academic Affairs, Student Records Section, reviews all grade reports submitted by course coordinators and clerkship/elective directors. **It is the responsibility of each student to check Canvas and BisonWeb to ensure courses, clerkships and electives are correctly recorded.** Grades are issued directly to the student on Canvas and BisonWeb, and are not released by fax, email, or to a third person. Requests for official and unofficial transcripts should be directed to the University Registrar's Office. **The College of Medicine does not have access to formal official transcripts.**

Satisfactory student performance, including demonstration of appropriate professional behavior, is mandatory for promotion and for graduation. Students are required to pass the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) Step 1 for promotion to the third year. Students are also required to pass the USMLE Step 2 Clinical Knowledge Examination (CK) to be eligible to participate in the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP) and to be eligible for graduation.

Grades in the College of Medicine are reported as H (Honors), HP (High Pass), S (Satisfactory), or U (Unsatisfactory) for medical students. High Pass (HP) designation is only available as a grade for all third-year clerkships except Emergency Medicine. Criteria for promotions and graduation are described in the Policies and Procedures Manual. The M4 course: Intern Readiness Course (IRC) is S/U course. Honors is not an option for this course.
