

A. Unscheduled Closure

1. Third year students

- During periods of delayed opening or unscheduled closures of the university, students will be excused from the clerkships during the delayed or closed period, but are expected to report for duty when conditions are safe and possible to do so.
- Make-up lectures and other learning sessions shall be rescheduled whenever possible
- Students shall not be required to make up the missed period unless the missed period includes make-up time for an earlier rotation, but will be responsible for the material that would have been covered during any lectures, small group session, or other learning activities.

2. Fourth year clerkships (AI on medicine and surgery)

- During periods of delayed opening or unscheduled closures of the university students on the required clerkships during the senior year are NOT excused from the clerkships unless access and safety prohibits travel.
- Make-up lectures, PBL or other learning sessions shall be rescheduled whenever possible

3. Electives

- During periods of delayed opening or unscheduled closures of the university students on the electives may be excused from the rotations at the discretion of the director for the elective. However students are encouraged to report for duty.
- Make-up lectures, PBL or other learning sessions shall be rescheduled whenever possible
